**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Wayne County Deputy Sheriff Civil Service Commission is taking applications for the position of Wayne County Entry Level Deputy Sheriff. The position of Wayne County Entry Level Deputy Sheriff involves service of process, investigation of crime and routine patrol activity.

Applications may be obtained at the Office of the Wayne County Clerk (room 106), Wayne County Courthouse, Wayne, West Virginia, during normal business hours. Completed applications must be returned to the Office of the Wayne County Clerk no later than 4:00 p.m., Monday, November 26, 2018.

Applicants must be citizens of the United States; residents of Wayne County; at least eighteen (18) years of age; of good moral character; and in good physical health.

To be eligible for the position of Wayne County Sheriff Deputy, all applicants must first successfully complete a competitive written examination, an oral interview, a physical examination, and meet such other criteria as established by West Virginia law and by the Wayne County Civil Service Commission for Wayne County Sheriff's Deputies.

The agility and competitive written examination shall be given to all eligible applicants on Saturday, December 8, 2018, at 8:30 a.m., at the Wayne High School football field, located at #1 Pioneer Road Wayne, West Virginia. This is for the agility test. Proper work-out attire is suggested. The written exam will be given at the Wayne County Courthouse, on the second floor (courtroom), located at 700 Hendricks Street Wayne, West Virginia. The time for the written exam is 10:00 a.m.
